

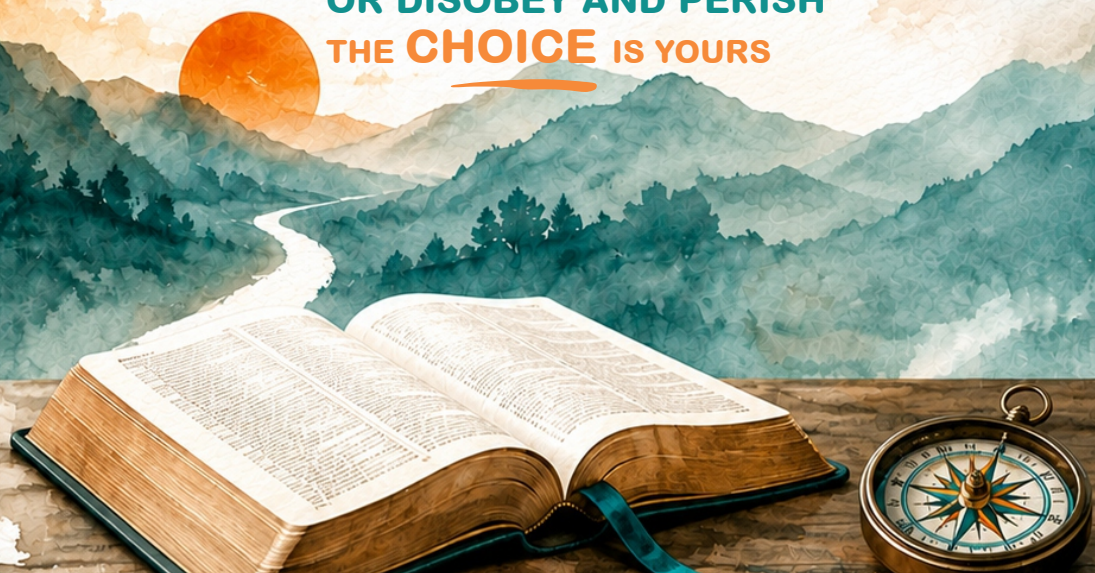

Stewardship, Departmental



We gather this season / year (2026) under a theme that is both an anchor and a compass: Focussed on Mission and Rooted in the Bible. As a church, we are not called to drift. We are called to be planted like the tree by the rivers of water in Psalm 1 deeply rooted in the unchanging Word of God, and at the same time reaching outward, branches extended toward a world that is waiting to hear the everlasting gospel. Mission without the Bible becomes noise. The Bible without mission

becomes a library. But when the two are held together Word and witness, roots and reach the church becomes what God always intended: a movement carrying present truth to the ends of the earth.

Our sub-theme sharpens this call into a personal decision: "Obey and Live, Disobey and Perish, The Choice Is Yours." The prophet Isaiah did not leave Israel room for neutrality. God, through His prophet, set before His people two roads and one choice: willing obedience that leads to the good of the land, or resistance and rebellion that leads to ruin. This is not a threat spoken in anger it is an invitation spoken in love, from a God who "pleads" with His people (Isaiah 1:18) before He ever speaks of consequence. He wants us to choose life.

That same choice stands before each of us this week on how we guard the Sabbath, on how we treat one another, on how we manage the time, talents, and treasure entrusted to our care, and in how urgently we carry the Three Angels' Messages to our community and to the world. Every sermon in the coming series will return to this single thread: Stewardship is not a fundraising technique it is obedience in action. What we do with what God has given us reveals whether we have truly said yes to Him.

To our visitors: you are not a stranger here. You are a guest of Heaven, and this congregation is simply the family God has gathered to receive you. Whatever brought you through these doors' if it is curiosity, or a friend's invitation, or the quiet leading of the Holy Spirit we are glad you came, and we pray you will sense the presence of Jesus among us.

To our members from the cradle roll, pathfinders, Sabbath School leaders, deacons, deaconesses, elders and every ministry team represented here, this is your moment. As we walk through the days of focused study on stewardship, we invite you to bring an open Bible, an open heart, and a willingness to obey whatever spirit of the Lord reveals.
